1 Adoption of the minutes and of the agenda

1.1 Minutes of the 32nd Plenary meeting – adoption

Three new items were added to AOB, concerning a new letter sent by [REDACTED] the GPA COVID-19 taskforce and the Public register of Art. 60 final decisions on the EDPB website. The agenda was adopted with the aforementioned changes.

2.2 Presentation of the European Commission report on the GDPR evaluation – information

The European Commission gave a presentation on its two GDPR Evaluation documents (Communication and Staff working document), where an analysis of the impact of the GDPR and a list of suggested actions to be carried out by several actors were included. The European Commission acknowledged the work carried out by the EDPB so far and stressed that all the tools offered by the GDPR should be used to their fullest, inviting the Board to consider the suggestions included in the two documents. An exchange of views concerning the future actions to be carried out by the Commission and by the Board followed. The European Commission also presented their communication on the implementation of the Law Enforcement Directive.

The Chair informed the Board that the EDPB has already communicated on these matters via tweets, therefore no need for a specific press release was seen.
