120th EDPB plenary meeting

28 May 2026 – Remote

I. Adoption of the agenda, Information given by the Chair

I.1. Introduction

The EDPB Chair informed the EDPB members that the next Global Privacy Assembly meeting will take place in Brussels, instead of Dubai as initially planned. The EDPB Secretariat is assisting the GPA with the organisation of the closed session which will take place on 16 and 17 November 2026. The public part of the GPA will be co-located with the IAPP Europe Congress and will take place at The Square in Brussels on 18 and 19 November.

I.2. Draft agenda of the 120th EDPB meeting

The draft agenda was adopted unanimously without modifications.

The discussions relating to agenda point B.1.1 were declared confidential in accordance with Art. 33(c) EDPB RoP.

B. Agenda items for discussion

B.1. Agenda items for discussion in view of adoption

B.1.1 Binding Decision on the dispute submitted by the Belgian SA on Vlaamse Radio-en Televisieomroeporganisatie (Art. 65 GDPR)

The EDPB Secretariat then presented the draft binding decision and the envisaged steps that would have to be taken after the adoption of the draft. The EDPB members discussed the document.

Several EDPB members expressed concerns with regard to the constantly growing number of complaints, including AI-generated ones, and recalled that SAs are required to handle them in spite of the difficulties they face due to limited resources. It was also stressed that SAs should be able to prioritise their work in order to ensure maximum efficiency and that the conclusion reached in the draft binding decision is limited to the circumstances of the concrete case.

The Binding Decision was adopted by the EDPB members. 22 EU members of the EDPB voted in favour of adoption. 2 EU member of the EDPB voted against and 3 EU members abstained. The 3 EEA members of the EDPB were in favour of adoption.

The EDPB Chair and the EDPB Secretariat underlined that the content of the Binding Decision cannot be made public until the Binding Decision is published on the EDPB website, which will occur after the BE and AT SAs take the necessary actions in compliance with Art. 65(6) GDPR, and in particular after the controller and the complainant are notified of the national decision or communication together with the EDPB binding decision.

As the SAs which have to take measures at national level do not have English as their official language, the EDPB Binding decision will be urgently translated into German and Dutch languages in accordance with Art. 11(7) of the EDPB Rules of Procedure.
