Final decision pursuant to Article 60 under the General Data Protection Regulation – Advokatguiden AS

Decision of the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection

IMY adopts the Norwegian Data Protection Authority's decision in Appendix 1 pursuant to Article 60(8) of the General Data Protection Regulation¹ (GDPR) and closes the case.

Presentation of the supervisory case

On the 16th of November 2021 the complainant filed his complaint with the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection (IMY). As the case concerns cross-border processing and Advokatguiden AS has its main establishment in Norway, IMY handed over the complaint to the Norwegian Data Protection Authority. The Norwegian Data Protection Authority has investigated the matter and issued a draft decision pursuant to Article 60(3) GDPR. None of the supervisory authorities concerned has expressed an objection to the draft decision pursuant to Article 60(4) GDPR.

Motivation for the decision

The Norwegian Data Protection Authority concluded that the agreement with the Swedish Bar Association essentially made the complaints obsolete. The complainant has been given the opportunity to comment but has not responded. The case has therefore been investigated to the extent appropriate according to Article 57(1)(f) of the GDPR and may be deemed resolved.

IMY and the other supervisory authorities concerned had no objections to the decision. Against this background, IMY shall adopt the decision pursuant to Article 60(8) of the Data Protection Regulation.

The case shall therefore be closed.
