Regarding paragraph 148 *“In most cases they should be able to just exercise their right, without their motivation being put into question”*:

Data deletion is not ONLY a risk to violate “storage limitation” principle, but also it is a risk for data subjects to delete irrevocably valuable data.

As a result, please change the strict language of Guidelines about possible violations of the *Article 12(2)* of GDPR. This is because controllers also taking care about data subjects and warn them prior to deletion, preventing accidental deletion.
